

Kids Kampus Activity Center

A fundraising project for a multi-purpose facility for the children of Kids Kottage Emergency Children's Center in Reno, NV



A need has been identified in our community that directly affects the children of Washoe County. The Reno Rodeo Foundation, Reno Rodeo Association and the Reno Rodeo Invitational Team Roping event produced by Perry Di Loreto have begun the process of a special fundraising effort to build a 10,000 square foot recreation and multipurpose facility within the Kids Kottage Family Kampus. The facility is managed by Washoe County Social Services. The goal is to raise the \$1 million needed to build the multipurpose facility. The Reno Rodeo Invitational Team

Roping event and the Reno Rodeo Foundation have committed to half the total money needed. These organizations are asking community members and leaders as well as organizations and foundations to donate money to realize the \$1 million goal to begin building the facility.

The Kids Kampus provides facilities for abused and neglected children in Washoe County that have been pulled from their home to be in a safer environment. Children using the facility range in ages from 1 month to 17 years. The Kids Kottage program is an emergency children's center that provides temporary housing for these children. Up to 62 children per day are using the facility. The children are currently using the residential facilities to play. The children must play indoors during the cold winter months and the heat of the summer. We need to build a place for our children to play.
